> Preventing Underage Drinking Takes a Lot of Tools!

No matter what issues your child is facing, one of the best things you can do to prevent them from turning to alcohol, is to talk with them.

- Short, frequent discussions can have a real impact on your child's decisions about alcohol.
- Lots of little talks are more effective than one "big talk."
- Make your views and rules about alcohol clear.
- As children get older, the conversation changes. Make sure your conversation is age appropriate.
- Be a good listener, remember that the conversation goes both ways.
- Teach kids how to say "No Thanks" when alcohol is offered.
- What you do is just as important as what you say. Be a model for your child.
