## Work with other parents to monitor where kids are gathering and what they are doing. Being involved in the lives of adolescents is key to keeping them safe.

- Make a plan about your teen responding to your calls and texts when they are away from home.
- Always know where your children are, what they are doing, who they are with, and with whom they are friends.
- Get to know the parents of your children's friends. Call them.
   Most will be happy to hear from you.
- Set clear rules about alcohol use and enforce the rules you set.
- Provide a safe, alcohol free place in your home for kids to gather.
